

Guidelines for the Best Post Graduate Award in Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal

- The application should be routed through the HoD

Eligibility criteria:

1. Postgraduates who had passed the MD/MS, April 2025 University Examination in the first attempt.
2. A minimum Performance and Accountability Report (PAR) score of 12
3. Postgraduate student should be a member of ARIMSA

Components: (Score = 100)

A. Educational Performance	-	25 marks
B. Conference attended/ Paper presentation/ Awards	-	20 marks
C. Paper Publications	-	15 marks
D. Conduct Certificate issued by the HoD	-	25 marks
E. Extracurricular activities	-	15 marks

Detailed breakup of the components:

A. Educational Performance (25 marks)

a. Marks secured in the MD/MS examination		
i. $\leq 55\%$	-	4 marks
ii. 56 – 60%	-	8 marks
iii. 61 – 65%	-	12 marks
iv. 66 – 70%	-	16 marks
v. 71 – 75%	-	20 marks
vi. 76 and above	-	25 marks

B. Conference attended/ paper presented/ awards (20 marks)

a. Conference attended (5)		
i. International conference of the speciality/related speciality-		2 marks
ii. National conference of the speciality/related speciality	-	1.5 marks
iii. Regional conference of the speciality/related speciality	-	1 mark
iv. Local conference/CME/ Workshop/ Hands on training of the speciality		
	-	0.5 mark

NB: Internet based CMEs will not be considered. However, the composition of the “related speciality” for a speciality will be decided by the Dean (Academics) on case to case.

b. Paper presented (10)		
i. International conference of the speciality/related speciality-		4 marks
ii. National conference of the speciality/related speciality	-	2 marks
iii. Regional/Local conference/CME/ Workshop/ Hands on training of the speciality	-	1 mark

- c. Awards (5)
 - i. First/ Best paper - 4 marks
 - ii. Second best paper/Travel Award - 3 marks
 - iii. Third best paper - 2 marks
 - iv. Consolation prize - 1 mark

C. Paper publications (Maximum – 15 marks)

- a. Paper published in journals indexed in PubMed/ Embase- - 5 marks
- b. Paper published in indexed journals recognised by NMC -3 marks
- c. Paper published in any other journals - 1 mark

Abstract published in the book of abstracts shall not be considered as a published article.

D. Performance and Accountability Report (PAR) score reported by the HoD (25 marks)

- a. The following criteria should be considered by the HoD
 - i. Punctuality - 4 marks
 - ii. Efficiency - 4 marks
 - iii. Behaviour with teachers/ colleagues/ subordinate staffs/ patients (wherever applicable) - 4 marks
 - iv. Attendance - 4 marks
 - v. Sincerity/ Integrity - 4 marks
 - vi. Readiness to take responsibility - 2 marks
 - vii. Any special contribution to the department -3marks
(Give a brief description when recommending)

HoD shall give the score

E. Extra-curricular activities (Maximum 15 marks)

- a. Participation in sports/ Cultural/ Literary activities in RIMSAM/ Youth festivals organised by the Universities/ Other state/ National level competitions and Blood donations during the course of the study (5)
 - i. Multi-event Participation in at least 3 streams -5 marks
 - ii. Single event participation in at least 3 streams or multi events (3) in a single stream -4 marks
 - iii. Any other -2 marks
- b. Prize winner (5)
 - i. First prize in two events -5 marks
 - ii. First prize in one event -4 marks
 - iii. Second prize -3 marks
 - iv. Third Prize -2 marks
- c. Blood Donation (as donor) (3)
 - i. 1 donation -1 mark
 - ii. 2 donations -2marks
 - iii. ≥ 3 donations -3marks
- d. Participation in Health Camp (2)
 - i. 1 Health Camp -1 mark
 - ii. > 1 Health Camps -2 marks


Participation certificate in any of the above extracurricular activities is a must for all applicant for the award.

In case of ties, the following points will be considered in order of their appearance.

1. Students with higher score in the PG examination
2. Student with higher score in the conduct marks given by the HoD
3. Students with higher score in extracurricular activities
4. Students with higher score in Conference attendance/ presentation

Score obtained by a candidate shall be cut off at the maximum obtainable score of that category irrespective of the number of participation or activity.

For awarding this prize, a candidate should obtain a minimum of 60% of the total marks, lest the award will be withheld for the year.



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
