Introduction:

The Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS), Imphal was established in the year 1972. It is an Institution of regional importance catering to the needs of the North Eastern Region in the field of medical education by providing undergraduate and post graduate courses, bringing together in one place the educational facilities for training of health personnel in all important branches of medical specialities, Dental and Nursing education. The Institute is affiliated to the Manipur University, Canchipur.

The Foundation Stone of the College of Nursing RIMS, Imphal was laid by Shri Ambumani Ramadoss, Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India in the year 2008. The College of Nursing, RIMS, Imphal was started in December, 2009 with an intake capacity of 50 students for B.Sc. Nursing Course and M.Sc. Nursing Course with an intake capacity of 8 students since 2019. 2(two) seats of M.Sc. Nursing course are also increased from the academic session 2022-2023. The College is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi and Manipur Nursing Council (MNC), Lamphelpat, Imphal for both B.Sc. & M.Sc. Nursing Courses and is affiliated to Manipur University, Canchipur, Imphal.

- 6. Demonstrate the ability to plan and effect change in Nursing Practice and in the Health Care Delivery System.
- 7. Establish collaborative relationship with members of other disciplines.
- 8. Demonstrate interest in continued learning for personal and professional advancement.

Course of studies:

The Institution at present offers the B.Sc. Nursing & M.Sc. Nursing Course of study and is recognized by Manipur Nursing council & Indian Nursing Council and affiliated to Manipur University.

Admission criteria for M.Sc. Nursing programme in College of Nursing, RIMS, Imphal (According to INC):

Eligibility criteria for admission:

- The Candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Council Registration.
- The Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc.Hons. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- The Candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing council.
- Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing from an approved Hospital/College/School of Nursing or a Community Health Setting/Programme after registration in the State Nursing Council.
- Candidate shall be medically fit.

Selection process:

- 1. A selection committee/ board will be formed for the selection process.
- 2. Selection of the candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by competent authority.
- If any candidates secured equal marks in the entrance examination, the selection will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in the last qualifying examination (B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing).
- 4. In case of any controversy the decision of Selection Committee will be the final.
- 5. Legal jurisdiction will be at Imphal.

Seats Distribution:

- 1(one) Seat will be distributed to each beneficiary states of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura.
- One seat is reserved for Nursing Staff working in RIMS and Staff working in the College of Nursing, RIMS, Imphal.
- 2(two) seats will be open to all beneficiary states based on Entrance Examination Result.
- If any candidate declines the seat of their respective state, the seat will be given to the candidate who secured the next highest mark in the entrance examination of their respective state.
- In case of vacant seat arise, the vacant seat will be treated as open based on the Entrance Examination result.

Submission of application:

- a) The Prospectus along with Application form can be downloaded from the RIMS website www.rims.edu.in or office of College of Nursing, RIMS, Imphal during office hours from 23rd May, 2024 onwards.
- b) The Candidate should fill in the application form in his/her own handwriting, clearly and legibly.
- c) Duly completed Application form should reach to the office of the Principal, College of Nursing, RIMS, Imphal on or before 29th June, 2024. The application forms should be submitted along with a Demand Draft of Rs.3,000/-(Rupees three thousand) only, for all categories, drawn in favour of Principal, College of Nursing RIMS, Imphal from a Nationalized Bank payable at Imphal as the cost of admission process fee and other charges.
- d) The demand Draft is non-transferable & non-refundable.
- e) Incomplete application forms shall be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained by the Institute in this regard. Complaints/Application forms received after the last date of submission of applications will not be entertained.
- f) Application of all in-service candidates should be routed through his/her employer irrespective of sponsored or open category.

Admission:

Following counseling, the selected candidates are required to get themselves admitted from 24th July, 2024 onwards by paying necessary fees and surrendering the following original documents to the College of Nursing, Regional Institute of Medical Sciences, Imphal.

- 1. State Nursing Council Registration Certificate.
- Marks sheets of B.Sc. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Examination.
- 3. University Degree certificate of B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Examination.

Penalty:

Penalty for the M.Sc. Nursing students leaving the course before the completion of 1(one) year will be Rs.1,00,000/- (One lakh only) and Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two lakhs only) thereafter before the completion of the course.

Attendance:

75% of the attendance for theory and practical for appearing University examination. However 100% of attendance for practical before the award of degree.

Examinations:

The examinations shall be organized on the basis of marking system to evaluate and certify candidate's level of knowledge, skill and competence at the end of the training and obtaining a minimum of 50% marks in theory as well as practical separately shall be mandatory for passing the whole examination. The examination for M.Sc. Nursing shall be held at the end of every academic year (Annual).

Research Dissertation:

Every student has to carry out one dissertation, which should be acceptable for publication in any Indian Nursing Journal or Indexed Journal. The research proposal should be submitted at the end of 9 (nine) months of First year M.Sc. Nursing course. The work should be completed and submitted in proper format at the end of 9 (nine) months of Second year M.Sc. Nursing course.
