No.ESTT-301/3/2024-GAD-GAD: In pursuance of the Election Commission of India letter No.78/EPS/2024 dated 16th March, 2024 and office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Manipur letter No.COE-101/2/2023-ELEC-ED dated 29th March, 2024, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to declare the 19th April (Friday), 2024 as a public holiday for all Public Offices, Educational institutions, Autonomous bodies, etc. and a paid holiday for Commercial/Private undertakings in the State located within the area of 47 (forty seven) Assembly segments under 1st phase of polling in connection with the General Elections to the 18th Lok Sabha, 2024 as per Section 135B of the Representations of the People Act, 1951. The list of the 47 Assembly Segments are as below,

Similarly, the Governor of Manipur is also pleased to declare the 26th April (Friday), 2024 as a public holiday for all Public Offices and Educational institutions, Autonomous Bodies, etc and a paid holiday for Commercial/Private undertakings in the State located within the area of 13 (thirteen) Assembly segments under 2nd phase of polling in connection with the General Elections to the 18th Lok Sabha, 2024 as per Section 135B of the Representations of the People Act, 1951. The list of the 13 Assembly Segments are as follows:

- 3. The Labour Commissioner cum Secretary, Govt. of Manipur will make necessary arrangements with all Private Enterprises, Private Industrial centres and other Private Institutions under the Shops and Commercials Establishment Act to declare the days of poll that is 19th April, 2024 and 26th April, 2024 as a paid holiday for all their employees. No deduction or abatement of the wages of any such persons shall be made on account of a holiday having been granted in accordance with law and if such person is employed on the basis that he would not accordingly receive wages for such a day, he shall nonetheless be paid for such a day, the wages he would have drawn had not a holiday been granted to him on that day.
- 4. Further, in exercise of the powers conferred by the explanation under Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (XXVI of 1881), the Governor of Manipur is pleased to declare as Public Holidays for all Banks, Financial Institutions & LIC located in the aforesaid assembly segments at para 1 and 2 above and that they shall remain closed on 19th April, 2024 (Friday) and 26th April, 2024 (Friday) respectively.
- 5. It is further ordered that, in order to enable to exercise right of franchise to those Government employees, Banks employees, Public Sector Undertakings employees, Commercial undertaking, etc. serving outside their assembly segments, as mentioned at Para 1 and 2 above, they shall be allowed to avail Special Casual Leave/paid leave on 19th April, 2024 (Friday) and 26th April, 2024 (Friday) respectively.
